

A passport sized photograph must be sent with your application form.**

Please allow 21 working days for the certificate to be issued from the date your application is received. Regrettably we are unable to respond to requests to check the progress of your ICC application within the first 14 days of this period. If you require your ICC sooner for an additional fee the fast track service guarantees a two working day turnaround from the date we receive your application and your certificate will be sent to you by 1<sup>st</sup> class post (or airmail if your address is outside UK). Tracked return delivery is available for a further additional fee (note this is not an express delivery service and provides tracking only not a guaranteed delivery date). The fast track service must be requested at the time of application and must be paid for with the application.



#### **DECLARATION & SIGNATURE OF APPLICANT**

I confirm that I have reached the age of 16 and I am physically and mentally fit to operate a pleasure craft, and in particular I have sufficient powers of vision and hearing to do so. I confirm I am the person in the passport size photograph provided with my application and that I have provided genuine documents to support my application. I understand that:

- the UK ICC issued by the RYA is issued under the authorisation and on behalf of the UK Maritime and Coastguard Agency;
- possession of this certificate does not entitle me to a certificate issued on behalf of any other organisation or any other national Government:
- the certificate is valid for 5 years from the date of issue and any requests to amend the certificate during its period of validity must be supported by documentation verifying the new details;
- should my eligibility change during the period the ICC is valid for I must notify the RYA and surrender the document and I
  will not be entitled to any refund:
- if I cannot satisfactorily demonstrate my continued eligibility when the certificate expires it will not be renewed by the RYA;
- the acceptance of the ICC is determined in accordance with both the vessel's flag state legislation and that of the country in which the vessel is to be used and it is my responsibility to ensure that the ICC is acceptable for its intended use; and
- the RYA will process the personal data I have given for the purpose of fulfilling this contract with me. My personal data will be processed in line with the RYA privacy policy www.rya.org.uk/go/privacy
